

















## DAY 01 DEPARTURE > OSLO

Breakfast | Dinner


- Excursion on board the Flam Railway Which has been described as one of the most beautiful train journeys in the world.

#### Breakfast | Dinner


- Arrive Hirtshals, continue to Åarhus, the second largest city of Denmark.

- · Overnight in Flyn region.


#### **DAY 09**

#### **FYN - COPENHAGEN**


#### Breakfast | Dinner


- · Continue to Copenhagen.
