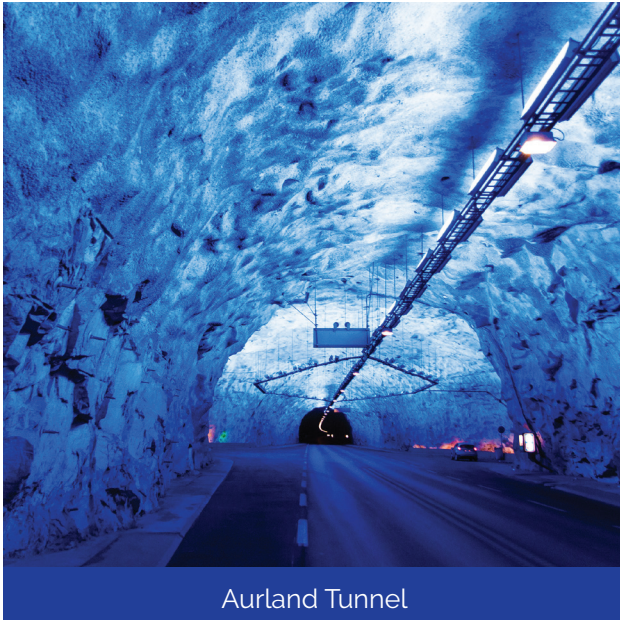

DAY 01 DEPARTURE > OSLO

Meals on Board

- Gather at the airport for your long-haul flight to **Oslo, Norway**.

DAY 02 OSLO

Dinner

- **Oslo city tour** - View of City Hall, Royal Palace, Oslo University. Photo stop at Vigeland Sculpture Park.

DAY 03 OSLO - GOL - AURLAND TUNNEL - VOSS/STAILHEIM

Breakfast | Dinner

- We leave Oslo this morning for spectacular fjord views.
- Travel through the world's longest road tunnel to Sognefjord region.
- Finish the day with a **photo stop at Stave Church** which was built sometime between 1180 and 1250 AD.
- Overnight in Voss / Stalheim.

DAY 04 VOSS/STAILHEIM - FLAM RAILWAY - TVINDEFOSSEN - BERGEN

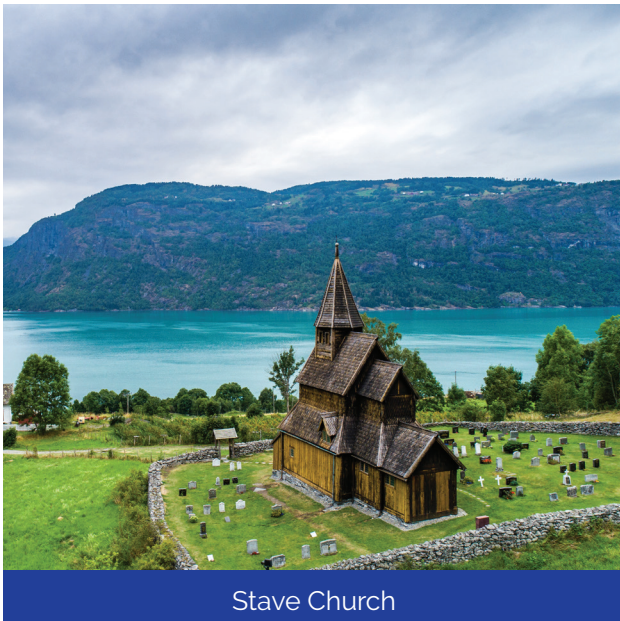
Breakfast | Dinner

- **Excursion on board the Flam Railway** - Which has been described as one of the most beautiful train journeys in the world.
- The train runs through spectacular scenery, alongside the Rallar Road, vertiginous mountainsides, foaming waterfalls and through 20 tunnels.
- Photo stop at **Tvindefossen**.
- Overnight in Bergen.

DAY 05 BERGEN - MT. FLOYEN - STAVANGER

Breakfast | Dinner

- **Bergen city tour** - Walk through medieval quarter of Bryggen and the open-air Fish Market. Take the **Floibanen Funicular** to get the best feel of the city.
- After lunch, embark on a scenic drive passing through Bjornafjorden & Boknafjord to Stavanger.
- Overnight in Stavanger Region.

DAY 06

STAVANGER - LYSEFJORD CRUISE - PULPIT ROCK

Breakfast | Dinner

- Embark on an excursion highlight of this trip - Lysefjord Cruise.
- Feast your eyes on the majestic **Pulpit Rock** soaring into the sky above incredible **Lysefjord** as you travel in comfort on the fjord cruise. Pulpit Rock became worldwide famous in the movie Mission Impossible.
- In the movie, Tom Cruise dangles from the towering cliff face high above the majestic Lysefjord, in true Ethan Hunt style.
- Afternoon, free time at leisure. For the more adventurous, you may want to join a guided hike to ascend Pulpit Rock.

DAY 07

STAVANGER - OVERNIGHT CRUISE

Breakfast | Dinner

- **Stavanger city tour** including photo stop at the **Stavanger Cathedral** and the **Valberg Tower**.
- Visit **old Stavanger** and **Øvre Holmegate**, known as "the street of colors."
- Some free time for shopping at the old town before we have an early dinner and board our cruise to Denmark.

DAY 08

HIRSTHALS - AARHUS - FYN

Breakfast | Dinner

- Arrive Hirtshals, continue to Åarhus, the second largest city of Denmark.
- **Aarhus city tour** - Marselisborg Palace and Memorial Park.
- Overnight in Flyn region.

DAY 09

FYN - COPENHAGEN

Breakfast | Dinner

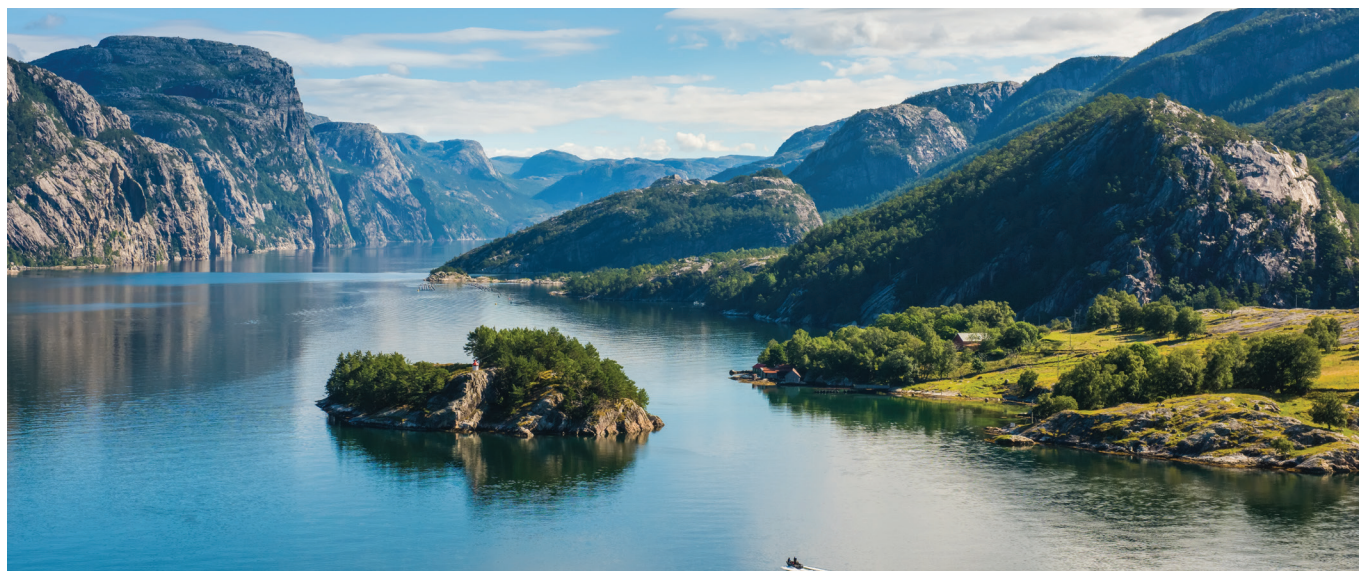
- Continue to Copenhagen.
- View **Tivoli Gardens**, **City Hall square**, **Hans Christian Andersen's Statue** and **Christiansborg Castle**.
- Photo stop at **Little Mermaid** and **Gefion Fountain**. If time permits, stop by Nyhavn, a waterfront, canal and entertainment district.

DAY 10

COPENHAGEN - NORTH ZEALAND EXCURSION - GOTHENBURG

Breakfast | Dinner

- Morning drive along the coast to Helsingør to admire the famous Kronborg, the magnificent **Renaissance castle**, designated UNESCO World Heritage Site, and setting of Shakespeare's Hamlet.
- Head to Sweden, driving through Helsingborg to arrive at Gothenburg.
- Drive past Dutch-style canals and leafy boulevards like the city's main thoroughfare, Avenyn, as well as see the **Old Town** and the **green oasis of Trädgårdsföreningen**.

DAY 11

GOTHENBURG - JÖNKÖPING - STOCKHOLM

Breakfast | Dinner

- **Jönköping** - An old trading centre in southern Sweden situated on the shores of three different lakes, one of which is Lake Vättern - the second largest in Sweden.
- Free time at leisure to explore Norrköping.
- Overnight at Stockholm.

DAY 12

STOCKHOLM > DEPARTURE

Breakfast | Meals on Board

- Visit the **City Hall**. View of the **Cathedral** and **Royal Palace**.
(Note: In the occasion the main building of Stockholm City Hall is closed for conference, we will only have a photo-stop of the exterior)
- Free time at the Old town before transfer to the airport.

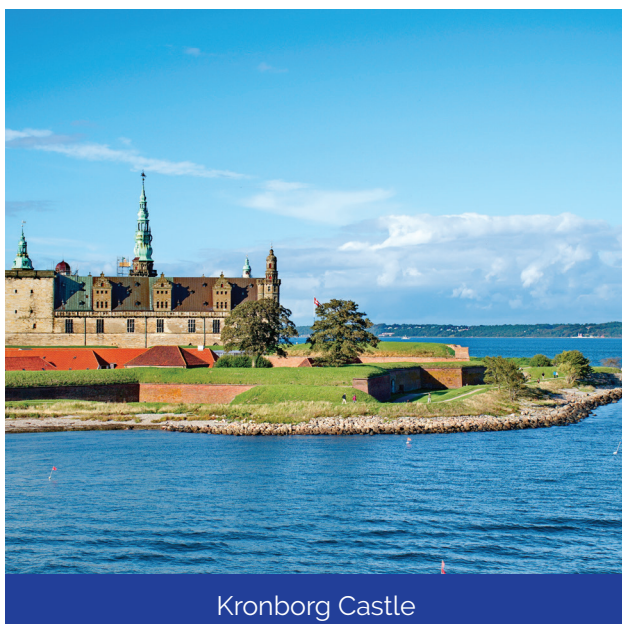
DAY 13
