












## DAY 01 DEPARTURE > MUNICH


- Visit Plitvice Lake National Park Walking tour through the park of 16 terraced lakes with 92 cascades and waterfall. Onboard boat cruise.

## DAY 08 DUBROVNIK - KOTOR - DUBROVNIK




- Take an excursion to Kotor, a coastal town in Montenegro and it's the only town on the eastern coast of the Adriatic Sea

## DAY 09 DUBROVNIK - MOSTAR - SARAJEVO




- Visit old town of Mostar with famous stone bridge on the river or Neretva.
- Sarajevo Sightseeing Visit the famous part of the city Bascarsija and walk through the street to see the local shop


