

#### NOTION SOFIA - RILA - PLOVDIV

- Rila Monastery (UNESCO) Bulgaria's largest and most famous monastery, renowned for its stunning architecture, rich history, and breathtaking mountain setting.
- Transfer to Plovdiv Regional Ethnographic Museum Plovdiv (Regional Ethnographic Open-Air Museum Etar), established in 1917 and since 1938 it has been located in Kuyumdzhieva house, a cultural monument of national significance.

#### 🚺 🖊 PLOVDIV - VELIKO TARNAVO

Breakfast | Lunch

- Plovdiv One of the oldest continuously inhabited cities in Europe, is a unique blend of ancient history and vibrant modern life. Walking tour of Plovdiv, including Old Town Plovdiv, Ancient Roman Theatre, and Folk Art Museum.
- Drive to Kazanluk Valley.
- Damascena Ethnographic Complex Located in the scenic Rose Valley, an area renowned for its exquisite rose oil production and stunning natural beauty.

#### NELIKO TARNAVO - BUCHAREST

Breakfast | Dinner

- Veliko Tarnovo stands as a testament to the rich tapestry of history and culture that defines the region.
- Tsarevets Fortress, the inescapable symbol of Veliko Târnovo, this reconstructed fortress dominates the skyline and is one of Bulgaria's most beloved monuments. Cross border into Romania, transfer to Bucharest.

#### NE BUCHAREST - SIBIU

Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

- Bucharest is the capital and largest city of Romania.
- Parliament Palace One of the heaviest buildings in the world, weighing about 4,098,500 tonnes, also being the second largest administrative building in the world.
- Guided walking tour of Bucharest, including The National Museum of the Village, Romanian Athenaeum, The Arch of Triumph. Transfer to Sibiu.

## 7 SIBIU

Breakfast | Lunch

- Sibiu Known for its German heritage, Sibiu is also named Hermannstadt and was chosen as European Cultural Capital in 2007. A city in the heart of Transylvania surrounded by the Carpathian Mountains.
- Walking tour of Sibiu, including Grand Square, Small Square, Bridge of Liars, Lutheran Church.
- Explore Old Town at leisure.

## SIBIU - BIERTAN - SIGHISOARA

Breakfast | Lunch

- Biertan Fortified Church (UNESCO) was built in the 12th century, being included in the list of UNESCO historical monuments since 1993.
- Transfer to Sighisoara for a guided walking tour, including Clock Tower.

## 📊 🗻 SIGHISOARA - BRAN - BRASOV

Breakfast | Dinner

- Dracula Castle Frequently linked to the legendary vampire Count Dracula. This Romanian fortress bears a striking resemblance to the Castle Dracula depicted in Bram Stoker's 1897 novel, as both are perched on rugged cliffs and offer stunning views.
- Transfer to Brasov for a city walking tour, including the Black Church.

## 1 BRASOV - BUCHAREST

- Slanic Prahova Salt Mine Renowned for its therapeutic benefits, is one of the largest in Europe
- Romania's Winery combines traditional winemaking practices with modern techniques, aiming to produce high-quality wines that reflect the unique characteristics of the region.


